


Conclusions

- The contradiction in Europe between science and religion did not exist in Islam because the Quran acknowledges that humans are gifted with the capacity to think and produce knowledge: insights into the living and non-living reality. Christian theology banned independent thinking from the Bible and thus sanctioned scientist.
- The Quran is not a textbook for astronomy or physics. The concept of creation deals with the question: how did something came out of nothing? Eurocentric science can not answer that question: what was before the big bang?
- What is the purpose of life and how is it related to creation? Science has no answer, because ethics is separated from knowledge.


